

## ADMINISTRATOR – PART TIME

Founded in 1963, the St Albans International Organ Festival stages a biennial festival in St Albans which has at its core two internationally renowned competitions for young organists.

Because of its cyclical nature, the Festival needs someone who is prepared to work flexibly. In a non festival year, the successful applicant will work a minimum of two days a week, whereas, in the months leading up to the Festival, the requirement is likely to be three or more days a week, with days and hours of work being agreed between the parties.
