Modal paraphrase on a Gregorian melody (free-style) (10') Given at Registration in St Albans

Free-choice (total timing 12') of contrasting movements from Paul Patterson: 'Games' op.37 (IOF commissioned work 1977)
Published by Josef Weinberger

Semi-Final Rounds

SF1: On the Mander organ, St Peter's Church, St Albans

Silent film improvisation (12')
Film given following announcement of semi-finalists
A set of Choral Variations in a German Baroque style or a Suite in a French Baroque Style (10')

SF2: On the 2013 Orgelbau Kuhn organ, Royal Academy of Music, London

Three contrasting movements with trumpet, based on literary texts (12') Texts given on announcement of semi-finalists

An Adagio & Scherzo in a romantic style on two given themes (10')

Final Round

On the Harrison & Harrison organ, St Albans Cathedral

Improvisation in three movements: Prelude, Scherzo and Finale (free choice of style) (max 20') Themes given on announcement of finalists
